

Official Contest Rules – KNEX – Sing It to Win It! Bad Bunny: World’s Hottest Tour

1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE OR WIN. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED, SOME RESTRICTIONS APPLY. Open to Laredo residents only.

2. SPONSORS: Radio United, LLC, including station KNEX “HOT 106.1” located at **216 W. Village BLVD Ste 101, Laredo, Texas 78041** (the “Station”). The administrator of the Contest is **Radio United LLC**

3. DATES OF THE CONTEST: “Sing It to Win It” (The “Contest”) begins on Friday August 26th, 2022 and ends on Friday September 2nd, 2022. Specific times and locations will be announced on-air.

4. ACCEPTANCE OF OFFICIAL RULES: By entering, you agree to be bound by these official contest rules (these “Official Rules”). 5. HOW TO ENTER/PLAY: To become a qualifier, Participants must send in an audio message finishing the lyrics to a favorite Bad Bunny song that will be chosen day of giveaway. The 6th audio message will be the winner if lyrics are sang correctly.
